Here's a schedule of last year's Dog Events:

7:30 – Registration in Cafeteria. Registration required for the 5K Dog Walk and Dog Parade, but NO race chips required.

8:00 - Visit the Pet Information Table for details on the 5k Dog Walk (starting at 9:15 -- that's 15 minutes after the 5k Run) and the 1-mile Dog Parade at 10:00.

8:30 – Pick up your free Doggie Toothbrush and Paste (compliments of Tenafly Pet Supplies) from the Pet Information Table and start practicing for the Best Kisser trophy - one of the judged events on the Dog Parade route.

8:40 – Ask The Experts! Christine Tilp from “Ain’t Misbehavin’ Dog Training” and Connie Formosa from “Canine Communications” will be at the Pet Information Table to answer your pet obedience, nutrition, training and health questions. A wonderful opportunity to get expert advice. (No Dogs on track or runner’s warm-up please).

8:45 – Learn a new trick and get an edge on the Parade competition! Bring your dogs to the blacktop behind the Gym for a session with Christine Tilp from “Ain’t Misbehavin’ Dog Training”. She will give you and pooch insider tips on scoring the trophy for Best Trick For A Biscuit.

9:10. Follow the leader! All Dogs registered for the 5K follow the leader from the blacktop to the Grassy Island.

9:15 – Dogs and Owners registered for the 5K Dog Walk. Meet at the Grassy Island in front of the School to begin the 5K course, following the same route as the runners. Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd place Dog finishers, but Dogs will NOT be CHIP scored. Start and finish at the same location. Treats served.

9:20 – Stump The Experts! Win a free phone consultation with a renowned Pet Psychic by telling us your quirkiest pet problem. Apply at the “Ask The Experts” station, Pet Information Table.

9:40 – Pick up your free poop bags at the Pet Information table, and give your dog a drink while you’re there.

9:55 – Get ready for the parade! Assemble on the blacktop. Treats for the most patient pets.

10:00 – Dog Parade begins on the blacktop. Start with the weave poles and follow the fun-filled agility course, which will include six judged trophy events: Dog & Human Look-A-Like, ● Best Barker, ● Cutest Coif, ● Best Trick For A Biscuit, ● Best Kisser and ● Best Dog & Human Dance team. Don't miss this! It's the highlight every year.

10:30 –All Dogs who complete the Parade collect a medal.

10:45 – Join Connie Formosa from Canine Communications on the field behind the blacktop for an enlightening demonstration on Dog Massage.

11:30 – Awards Ceremony. Be there to pick up your Trophy.

12:00 – TEF Annual Raffle Drawing.
